Dennis Brown is helping. His company has a new four-color electronic printing press that will help us to enhance what you get in the mail.

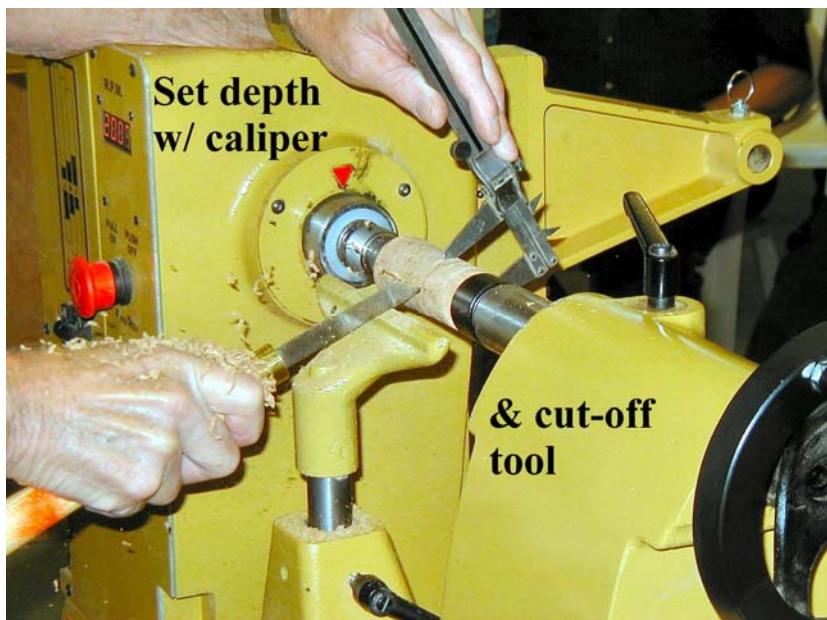
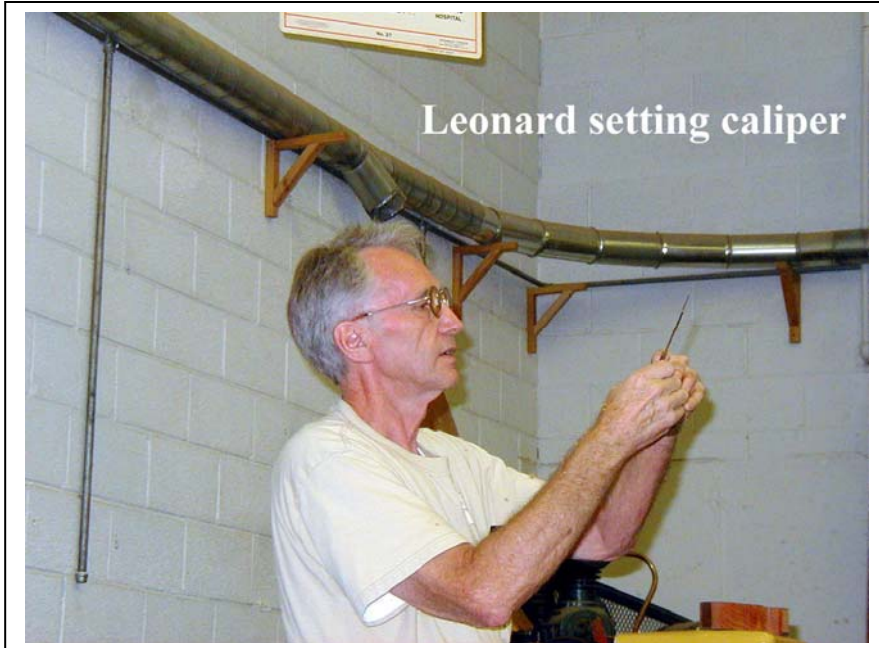
Our August 3, 2004 meeting was held at Timberline Woodworkers Supply in Orem.

Demonstration:

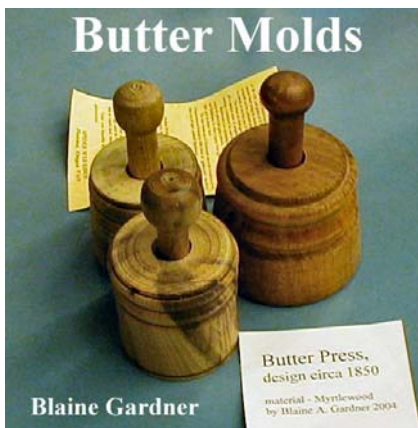
Leonard Cleveland then demonstrated a bird house with a natural surface (see the picture of a stand with many bird houses on it - page 3).
